She also reported that almost all of MTS staff attended Shawano's Mission Impossible week long training last summer and were trained in PBIS and Morning Meeting. They are piloting PBIS this school year and a handful of teachers are using the Responsive Classrooms Morning Meeting approach. Shawano is using Lucy Caulkins for ELA and Singapore Math for Math.</p> <p>Faith Gagnon reported on the happenings at Bowler School. They are experimenting with departmentalizing in 3rd/4th grade and 5th/6th grade where teachers teach subject specific course. STAR Testing is given 4 times a year and they are working with teachers to analyze the data and make improvements in their teaching. They will also be hosting a grandparents day where grandparents will come in for breakfast as well as be able to spend some time with their grandchildren in the classroom.</p>	Informational only
